From 1st July 2024, Inclusion Australia Northern Territory (IANT) will be supported by the South Australian Council on Intellectual Disability (SACID) instead of Inclusion Australia.



SACID is the South Australian member of Inclusion Australia.



SACID speaks up about issues that are important to people with intellectual disability and their families in South Australia.



SACID does similar work to IANT and will support IANT for everyday projects and other work.



This change means Inclusion Australia will have more time to focus on speaking up for people with an intellectual disability across Australia.



The team at IANT will stay the same. They will work for SACID instead of Inclusion Australia.
